This document explains the improvements that affect the Full Ridership Reports in the latest **AVL GPS Tracking** release (SF Cloud Application Suite v5.59.1).

# Enhancements

In order to provide more comprehensive information and enhance consistency between search and report parameters in the application, the Full Ridership Report includes a field for vehicle identification that allows using this parameter to filter the data to be presented in the report. This field is available in both **Instant Report** and **Scheduled Report** dialogs.

The vehicle information is accordingly presented in the **Parameters** section of the dialog (see bottom of the second image), and a dedicated column for vehicle identification named **Vehicle ID** is displayed in the resulting report.
