# **BWX Mobile App**



# User's Guide version 3.8



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#### Introduction



BWX Mobile is an app used to view videos from your smart phone or tablet in the field. This application is available for iOS and Android devices.

In addition to viewing recorded videos on BWX Mobile, you can also use BWX Mobile to view a live video feed, assign video categories, and remotely start/stop recordings.

#### Pairing Your BWX-100 with BWX Mobile

If you are logging into BWX Mobile for the first time, please note the BWX-100 serial number you wish to pair with. It is printed on a silver sticker on the bottom of the unit.

- **1** If you have not done so already, download the BWX Mobile app from the App Store.
- 2 Make sure that Bluetooth and WiFi are enabled on your iOS or Android device.
- **3** Ensure that Cellular Data is disabled on your device.
- **3** Tap the **BWX Mobile** icon on your device's Apps list.





If a password screen displays, proceed to the next step. Otherwise skip to step 7

**4** Tap on the *Password* field. A numeric keyboard displays.

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- **5** Using the numeric keyboard, enter your password.
- 6 Tap **Submit**. The following screen displays.





7 Press and hold the Snap/Trace button on your BWX-100 until the words "READY TO PAIR" display on the LCD screen.



**8** If you see the "Pair with..." link at the bottom of the screen (Pair with BWX-100-3000000345) and the displayed serial number matches your device, tap on that link. Proceed to the next step.

– OR –

If you do *not* see the "Pair with…" link at the bottom of the screen, or you see the link but the displayed serial number does *not* match your device, tap **Select Device**. Skip to step 10.

**9** If you have an iOS device, skip to step 12.

– OR –

If you have an Android device, End of Procedure.

**HINT**: If more than one device displays, you can identify your particular BWX-100 by its 10-digit serial number, which is printed on a silver sticker on the bottom of the device.

**10** Tap on your device's serial number to select it. A checkmark appears to the right of that device.





**11** Tap the **PAIR** option on the upper right side of the screen. A status message displays.



Once the BWX-100 successfully pairs with your iOS or Android device, the words "Paired Successfully" display at the top of the screen.



- 12 Tap Next.
- 13 Tap the ≡ icon in the upper left corner of the screen. A selection menu displays.





14 Tap Settings. The Settings screen displays.

- **18** Tap **Paste** to insert the password from the clipboard to the *Password* field.
- **19** Tap **Join**. Your iOS device connects to the BWX-100 network.
- **20** Return to the BWX Mobile app and tap **Check Live View**. Verify that the live feed displays, as illustrated in "Checking the Live View" on the next page.





# **Checking the Live View**



#### Assigning a Category to a Video

There are three ways to assign a category to a video:

- 1 From the BWX-100, immediately following a recording.
- 2 From your video management software, after uploading the video to the server.
- From BWX Mobile, *after* you stop a recording but *before* you upload the video to the server. This procedure is described here.
- **1** Tap the  $\equiv$  icon in the upper left corner of the screen. A selection menu displays.

2 Tap Videos. A list of recently recorded videos displays. If you assigned video categories to some, but not all, of your videos, the screen will be divided into two parts: **To-Do** (uncategorized videos) and **Done** (categorized videos).



**3** Scroll through the To-Do list and tap on the category you wish to assign to each video. Each time you do so, a confirmation message will display: *Category has been set successfully*.

Once you've finished categorizing all videos on the "To-Do" list, the following message displays.





#### **Playing a Video**

**1** Tap the  $\equiv$  icon in the upper left corner of the screen. A selection menu displays.



2 Tap Videos. A list of recently recorded videos displays. The screen is divided into two parts: **To-Do** (uncategorized videos, if any) and **Done** (categorized videos).





- **3** Scroll through the video list.
- $\Rightarrow$  If you see the video you wish to play, tap the Play button. **End of Procedure**.
- $\Rightarrow$  If you do *not* see the video you wish to play, or the message "No uncategorized" displays, tap the **Done** tab. The categorized video list displays.
- **4** Scroll through the second video list until the desired video displays, then tap the Play button.



#### Starting/Stopping a BWX-100 Recording from BWX Mobile

If desired, you can trigger a recording directly from BWX Mobile. You can also stop a recording that is currently in progress.



#### **Unpairing Your BWX-100 from BWX Mobile**

Once you're finished viewing/categorizing videos in BWX Mobile, follow this procedure to disconnect or "unpair" the two devices.

- Tap the ≡ icon in the upper left corner of the screen. A selection menu displays.
- 2 Tap Unpair. A verification message displays.

**3** Tap **OK**. A confirmation message displays: *Successfully Unpaired*.

- **1** Tap the  $\equiv$  icon in the upper left corner of the screen. A selection menu displays.

The fields on this screen are described below.

Field	Description
Body Worn Camera Name	The device's agency-assigned name.
Mobile App Version	The version of BWX Mobile that is currently installed on this BWX-100 device.
Serial Number	The 10-digit serial number assigned to this device. This number is also printed on a silver sticker on the back of the camera.
Firmware Version	The firmware version that is currently assigned to this device. When a new firmware version is available, it will automatically download to the BWX-100 during the next device-to-server com- munication.
Model Number	The model number for this device.
Battery Status	The percentage of charge remaining in this device's battery. The higher the percentage, the stronger the battery charge. A value of 100%, for example, indicates that the battery is fully charged.
Storage Status	The percentage of storage space used on this BWX-100's internal micro USB drive. The higher the percentage, the less space there is. Once you upload video to the server, this percentage will reset to $0$ .
About MVI Mobile-Vision	A link that displays a history of Mobile-Vision.

#### **Adding a Password**

This section describes how to add a numeric security password to BWX Mobile. When you do so, you will be prompted to enter that password whenever you attempt to login to the app.

**1** Tap the  $\equiv$  icon in the upper left corner of the screen. A selection menu displays.



**2** Tap **Settings**. The Settings screen displays.

**3** Tap on the *Password Settings* field. The Password screen displays.



**4** Tap on the *Password* field. A numeric keyboard displays.

2 Tap Settings. The Settings screen displays.





**3** If a blue dot displays to the right of the *Password Security* field, proceed to the next step.

If a white dot displays to the right of the *Password Security* field, tap on it. The ball turns blue.

4 Tap on the *Password Settings* field. The Password login screen displays.



**5** Tap on the *Password* field. A numeric keyboard displays.

#### **Removing the Password Requirement**

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#### **Reinstating the Password Requirement**

**3** Tap the blue ball. The ball turns blue, indicating that the password requirement is now *on*.
