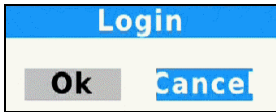


## Login Using Your USB Login Key

- 1 If you have not done so already, copy your login information from the DES server to a USB memory stick. For specific instructions, see “Generating a DVR Login Key” in chapter 1 of your DES *Officer’s Guide*.
- 2 Insert the USB memory stick in the DVR’s USB port.



- 3 Press **T**. The Login screen displays.



**NOTE:** If this screen says *Logout* instead of *Login*, it means that the last officer to use this DVR forgot to logout. To fix this problem, continue with steps 4 – 5 to log the last officer out, and then repeat steps 3 – 5 to log yourself in.

- 4 Press **▶▶** or **◀◀**.
- 5 Press **R**.
- 6 Remove the USB memory stick.

## Logout

Repeat steps 3 – 5 above.

## Activate Nite-Watch Feature



Press here to activate the Nite-Watch feature

### Use the other buttons to:

- Z** Zoom in, pause for several seconds, then return to a wide-angle view
- F** Manually initiate a focus operation
- I** Zoom in
- O** Zoom out
- B** Reveal scene details when the camera is facing into the sun
- ☾** Toggle the camera buttons’ backlight on/off

## Start a Recording

Regular recordings can be initiated in one of two ways: *manually* or *automatically*. Manual recordings are initiated by the officer in different ways, as described below. Automatic recordings are initiated by the DVR in response to pre-programmed “trigger” actions, such as turning your emergency lights on. For more information on record triggers, see “Selecting & Configuring Record Triggers” in the *Flashback3 & FlashbackHD User’s Guide*.

To manually start a recording, first check to make sure the *Verifying Storage* message no longer displays. Next, perform **one** of the following actions:

- 1 Press **R** on the DVR, or...



- 2 Press **R** on the monitor, or...



- 3 Slide the button on the front of your VLX mic **down**. **NOTE:** In order to initiate a recording from the VLX, the device must be turned on, its battery must be charged, and it must be configured as a record trigger.

If you press the **R** button a **second** time, it will mute the in-car audio.

## Stop a Recording & Assign a Video Category

To stop a recording, press **STOP**. The first video category displays. To assign this category to your video, **do nothing**. To assign a *different* category to your video, continue pressing **STOP** until the desired category displays. Once five seconds have elapsed without pressing **STOP**, the system will link the displayed category to your video.

## Play Back a Video

- 1 Make sure the door to your DVR is locked and Auto mode is *off*. (If necessary, press the **AUTO** button until the **AUTO** light turns *off*.)
- 2 Press **PLAY/PAUSE**. The Playlist displays in either “image” or “list” view. To toggle back and forth between these two screen views, press **T**.
- 3 Press the **RIGHT** or **LEFT** button until the correct file is highlighted.
- 4 Press **PLAY/PAUSE**. The default video/audio track begins playing. The default *video* track is Camera channel 1 (forward-facing zoom camera), and the default *audio* track is VLP 1 port (VLX microphone that’s connected to input port VLP 1).
- 5 To select a *different* video and/or audio track, proceed to the next step. Otherwise skip to step 17.
- 6 Hold the **PLAY/PAUSE** button **down** until the Select Source menu displays.
- 7 To select a different *camera* view, proceed to the next step. Otherwise skip to step 11.

- 8 Press **R** to select the *Video* field.
- 9 Press **RIGHT** to toggle between the two camera channels:
  - **Cam #1.** Display the view from the forward-facing zoom camera.
  - **Cam #2.** Display the view from all other cameras in a “split-screen” format. This includes the Backseat camera and any Bullet camera(s).
- 10 Press **T** to save your camera selection.
- 11 To select a different *audio* track, proceed to the next step. Otherwise skip to step 16.
- 12 Press **RIGHT** to advance to the *Audio* field.
- 13 Press **R** to select the *Audio* field.
- 14 Press **RIGHT** until the desired audio track displays:
  - **MIC #1.** Play the audio track for the VLX wireless microphone that’s connected to input port VLP 1.
  - **MIC #2.** Play the audio track for the VLX wireless microphone that’s connected to input port VLP 2.
  - **MIC #3.** Play the audio track for the in-car microphone.
- 15 Press **T** to save your audio selection.
- 16 Press **T** to exit the Select Source menu and begin playing the selected video/audio track. Depending on your selections and camera configuration, this may be a single or “split-screen” view.
- 17 When you’re done viewing the video(s), press **STOP** to exit the Playlist screen.
