

Remote Power Indicator for Trooper and Explorer DVR Systems

Quick Installation Sheet

Introduction

The remote power indicator is mounted in a vehicle panel and illuminates when the cameras are powered on. This *Quick Installation Sheet* describes how to install the remote power indicator with an existing Trooper or Explorer DVR System. The remote power indicator is supplied with a 20 ft (6.1 m) cable and 2.1 mm connector that connects to the POWER or AUX POWER connector on the DVR back panel.

In order to access the DVR back panel, the lock box key is required to unlock the door of the lock box. For complete information, see the *Installation and User's Guide* for your DVR system.

Installing the Remote Power Indicator

Suggested tool include a power drill with a ¹/₂" drill bit.

To install the remote power indicator:

- 1. Turn off all power to the DVR.
- 2. Drill a ¹/₂" hole in the desired location. Ensure that the area behind the hole is clear of obstructions before drilling.
- 3. Feed the connector and cable through the mounting hole. Secure the remote power indicator into position.
- 4. Route the connector end of the cable to the location of the DVR.
- 5. Unlock the lock box door and slide the DVR out of the lock box.
- 6. Connect the 2.1mm connector to the appropriate power connector (POWER1 or POWER2, or PWR1 or PWR2 on the Explorer DVR; AUX POWER on the Trooper DVR.)
- 7. Slide the DVR into the lock box and secure the lock box door.
